## THE ENVIRONMENT PROTECTION AGENCY, 2003

#### Short title:

THE ENVIRONMENT PROTECTION AGENCY (ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMEN, PERMIT/LICENSE, 2015) REGULATIONS, 2015

In exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon the National Environment Policy Council, Republic of Liberia, by Section 29.1 of the Environmental Protection and management Law, 2003, the Council hereby approves the following Regulations:-

#### Application for License/Permit:

- 1. Any project proponent who plans to undertake or cause to be undertaken any of the projects as set out in Annex I (Section 6) of the Environmental Protection and Management Law, 2003; in fulfillment of the requirements Section 37 of the Environment Protection Agency Act, 2003, shall apply to the Agency for a License and or Permit.
- 2. The application shall be in the form as set out in schedule I of these Regulations.
- 3. The application shall be accompanied by a concise description of the project or activities to be undertaken, which description shall include all information set out in Schedule I and any additional requirements as may be deemed necessary for the processing of the license and or permit applied for.

#### Issuance of License/Permit:

Upon review of an application and its accompanied requirements, the Agency shall make a decision (approve, conditionally approve or deny) on the issuance of a license and or permit in the form and manners as set out in Section 21of the Environmental Protection and Management Law, 2003.

## Fees for License/Permit:

- 1. For the processing and monitoring of a license and or permit, as provided for under Section 29 of the Environmental Protection and Management Law, 2003, the Agency shall charge the fees as set out in Schedule II below.
- 2. For the processing and monitoring of a project, fees charged for issuance of a permit shall be on the basis of Environmental Impact and Monitoring Cost Analysis (EIMCA) which shall take into account the following factors including but not limited to:
  - a. The nature of the project activities;
  - b. The level of environmental pollution;
  - c. The proximity of the project to human settlement;
  - d. The potential impacts of the project on the environment;
  - e. The potential impacts on the socio-economic life of the project affected community(PAC).
  - f. The total amount of land area the project is expected cover;
  - g. The total capital outlay of the project.

### **Monitoring:**

- 1. The Agency shall monitor all activities of project proponent to ensure that all permitting terms and conditions and other adverse impacts incidental to the operations of the project comply with the requirements of the EPA Act.
- 2. For the purpose of ensuring full compliance with requirements of the Act, monitoring of any and all project activities shall take into considerations factors including but not limited to:
  - a. The intensity of the potential impacts of the project on the environment;
  - The intensity of the potential impacts of the project on the socio-economic life of the Project Affected Community (PAC);
  - c. The complexity of the nature of the project;
  - d. The complexity of the project site;
  - e. The potential size of the amount of land the project is to occupy;
  - f. Other potential adverse impacts of the project that are undetectable at the time of processing the permit.

#### **Schedule I**

- a. Name, address, phone number and email address of project proponent;
- b. Nature of the project;
- c. Design of the project;
- d. Location of the project (County, District and Community)
- e. Activities to be undertaken;
- f. Proposed time frame of the project;
- g. Total estimated capital expenditures;
- h. Number of people expected to be employed by the project.

## **EXPLANATORY NOTES**

Licenses/permits are granted by the Environment Protection Agency to enable a project proponent (whether an individual or a company) to undertake any project as set out in Schedule III.

Fees charged for the issuance of licenses/permits depend on the category in which the project fall in keeping with Schedule III. The fees are also derived base on the potential impacts of the project on biodiversity and the number of monitoring required to ensure that the project activities do not adversely impact the environment,
